Fast-start workflow checklist for coaches, video staff, and scouts

Kaish App	Kaish Capture	Kaish Scout
Tag, review, teach, present, report, and share on iPad.	Record or code video on Mac, then export Capture Share Files.	Organize player evaluation, reports, rosters, and sharing on web.

Capture = input. Kaish = brain.

1. Overview

Kaish has three main working areas:

- Kaish App: coach, tag, review, present, report, and sync.
- Kaish Capture: record or code video on Mac, then export a Capture Share File.
- Kaish Scout / web: browser-based team, player, workspace, billing, and scout workflows where enabled.

Use Share File language in front of users:

- Game Share File.
- Capture Share File.
- Presentation Share File.
- Review Share File.
- Recovery Backup File.

2. Fastest Kaish App Workflow

- Sign in.
- Choose the correct workspace.
- Create a game.
- Confirm sport, opponent, home/away, segment length, roster, and lineup.
- Open Live Tag.
- Start the game clock/segment.
- Tag events as they happen.
- Track active players for minutes/TOI.
- Attach video after the game.
- Use Set Sync for app-created live tags.
- Open Review.
- Verify clips.
- Build a playlist.
- Create a presentation.
- Export report/PDF or Share File.

3. Fastest Kaish Capture Workflow

- Open Kaish Capture on Mac.
- Sign in with a Capture-enabled account.
- Choose Live Capture.
- Confirm Blackmagic device and preview.
- Create a new session.
- Start recording.
- Press tag buttons during the event.
- Stop recording.
- Save/export the Capture Share File.
- Import the Capture Share File into Kaish App.

4. Fastest Code Existing Video Workflow

- Open Kaish Capture.
- Choose Code Existing Video.
- Add a video.
- Play, pause, scrub, and tag.
- Preview clips.
- Add clips to a queue if needed.
- Export Capture Share File for Kaish App.
- Export Presentation Share File if you built a presentation queue.
- Code Existing Video should keep your loaded video and unsaved tagging state when you switch to Live Capture and back.

5. Import Capture Work Into Kaish App

New Game From Capture

- Open Kaish App.
- Tap New Game.
- Tap Import Capture Share File.
- Choose the file from Kaish Capture.
- Open the imported game.
- Attach/relink video if prompted.
- Open Review and test clip timing.

Existing Game

- Open the existing game.
- Choose Import Capture Share File.
- Select the file.
- Confirm the segment if prompted.
- Open Review and verify tags.

6. Sport Setup Cheat Sheet

Hockey

Use for:

- Periods.
- Countdown clock.
- On-ice TOI.
- Lines, pairs, goalies.
- Shots/goals for and against.



- Faceoff wins/losses.
- Strength labels when useful.

Basketball

Use for:

- Quarters.
- Countdown clock.
- On-court minutes.
- 2PT, 3PT, FT.
- Opponent scoring.
- Rebounds, fouls, timeouts, turnovers.

Soccer

Use for:

- Halves.
- Count-up clock.
- Stoppage time.
- On-field minutes through stoppage time.
- Goals, shots, saves, corners, fouls, cards.
- Own and opponent stats.
- Advance halves manually. Soccer should not auto-stop at 45:00 or 90:00.

Lacrosse

Use for:

- Quarters.
- Countdown clock.
- On-field minutes.
- Goals, shots, saves.
- Faceoffs, clears, rides, ground balls, turnovers, penalties.
- Own and opponent stats.

Other / Field Sport

Use for:

- Flexible groups.
- Shot/Opp Shot.
- Score/Opp Score.
- Save.
- Turnover.
- Foul.
- Sub.



7. Timing Rules

- Normal event/stat tags use wall elapsed time for video alignment.

Player timing tags use clock-based timing:

- SHIFT.
- PLAY.
- TOI/minutes.
- Lineup or group duration.

Soccer is the exception for overrun: because soccer counts up, player timing can continue past the configured half length during stoppage time.

- Capture-imported tags keep Capture timing. Do not remap Capture timing through Set Sync.

8. Review And Fullscreen

- Use Review to validate clips before sharing or presenting.

Clip mode:

- Opens when an active clip is playing.
- Scrubber shows clip duration.
- Skip stays inside the clip.
- Pause resumes in place.

Full video/segment mode:

- Opens when no clip is active.
- Scrubber spans the active video or segment.
- Useful for coach/scout review tagging while watching full video.

9. Playlist And Presentation Basics

- Review clips first.
- Add useful clips to a playlist.
- Reorder the playlist.
- Add notes.
- Send to Presentation.
- Play selected clips or the full presentation.
- Export Presentation Share File if needed.
- Baked coach clips are rendered videos. In normal presentation playback, they behave like regular video clips.

10. Reports And Sharing

Before exporting:

- Open Reports.
- Confirm the game or date range.
- Confirm sport labels.
- Confirm score and key stat totals.



- Export PDF or supported compatibility file.
- Use Share Files for Kaish-to-Kaish workflows.
- XML compatibility exports are only for workflows that require XML import support.

11. Sync And Recovery

Open Sync & Recovery when you need to:

- Push/pull cloud workspace data.
- Share Game Share Files.
- Import Game Share Files.
- Share/import roster or review data.
- Create or restore local recovery backups.
- Delete local-only or workspace games.
- Use manual sync intentionally. Pro users can still use local Share File workflows even when cloud sync is locked.

12. Share File Map

Use this file type for this job:

- Capture session from Mac to Kaish App: Capture Share File.
- Full game data from Kaish App to another device: Game Share File.
- Presentation queue or imported presentation: Presentation Share File.
- Review notes/playlists/telestration for an existing game: Review Share File.
- Local safety restore: Recovery Backup File.
- Advanced note: Share Files may have a .json extension. That is normal.

13. Common Fixes

Capture Cannot See Hardware

- Install supported Blackmagic Desktop Video.
- Check the device connection.
- Close other Blackmagic apps.
- Restart Kaish Capture.
- Confirm preview status.

Capture Access Denied

- Confirm you signed into the right account.
- Choose the correct workspace.
- Confirm Elite access or Team Capture seat.
- Ask an owner/admin to verify access.



Imported Clips Do Not Play

- Attach/relink the source video.
- Confirm the segment.
- Open Review.
- Test several clips.

App-Created Tags Do Not Align

- Attach video.
- Use Set Sync.
- Test several tags near different times.
- Confirm the correct segment video is selected.

14. Manual Smoke Checklist

Before launch or before a big team rollout:

- Clean install.
- Sign in.
- Restore session.
- Choose workspace.
- Create hockey game.
- Create basketball game.
- Create soccer game and test stoppage time.
- Create lacrosse game.
- Test active player timing.
- Attach video.
- Set Sync.
- Review clip mode fullscreen.
- Review full-video fullscreen.
- Build playlist.
- Build presentation.
- Export PDF/report.
- Export Game Share File.
- Import Game Share File on another device.
- Open Kaish Capture.
- Confirm Capture access.
- Test Live Capture.
- Test Code Existing Video.
- Export Capture Share File.
- Import Capture Share File into Kaish App.
